# **Derby Community Foundation Community Enrichment Grants**

#### WHAT ARE COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT GRANTS?

Community Enrichment Grants are grants of up to \$2,500 made to grassroots non-profits and government entities doing innovative and meaningful work that fits within the Derby Community Foundation's mission and that enriches or responds to immediate needs within the community.. Community Enrichment Grants expand the Foundation's support to a broad range of organizations throughout the Derby area. The Foundation awards up to \$10,000 annually in two cycles per year using a competitive application process.

Mission of Derby Community Foundation is to enrich the quality of life in the Derby area by being a catalyst for connecting people and resources with community needs and initiatives.

The Community Enrichment Grants Program is competitive, because a limited amount of funding is available each year. As with any competitive process, the grants are awarded to the applicants whose projects best fit our mission. The Foundation regrets that funds are not available to recognize the meaningful work of all who apply.

#### WHEN IS THE DEADLINE?

Application deadlines are **November 22** and **May 15** each year. Grant announcements are mailed by the Foundation within approximately 45 days following the application deadline.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any tax-exempt, non-profit organization or government entity using the funds for a project meeting the Foundation's mission is eligible to apply. Specifically, organizations should meet the criteria shown below.

#### WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA?

Projects must meet the Foundation's mission. In addition, the organization must be:

- 1. Classified as tax-exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Service Code, or a governmental entity
- 2. Provide services within the Derby USD 260 boundaries
- 3. Not a previous recipient of a Community Enrichment Grant within the past 12 months Examples of organizations that may apply include:
  - Schools, church groups, youth organizations (Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, etc.)
  - Government & Municipal Agencies (Police Department, Fire Department, Library, Senior Center, etc.)
  - Civic Club or Organization (Rotary, Optimist, Lions, etc.)
  - Public Foundations & Support Groups (Red Cross, Victory in the Valley, etc.)

#### **FUNDING LIMITATIONS**

Funding will not be provided to support the following:

- Clinical or medical research
- Contributions to capital campaigns
- Organizations that practice discrimination by race, color, creed, sexual orientation, gender, age or national origin
- Operating deficits or retirement of debt
- Endowment programs are typically not funded
- Construction projects or real estate acquisitions
- Political projects of any kind
- Vehicles, such as vans or buses
- Programs that promote a specific religious denomination
- Projects that have received a Community Enrichment Grant in the past 5 years.

#### **DEADLINES/GUIDELINES**

- The Derby Community Foundation does not provide funding to private foundations.
- Due diligence will be conducted to verify the non-profit status of your organization. Please be certain to include proper contact information so that this verification may occur.
- Grants are for amounts up to \$2,500.
- Application deadlines are **November 22** and **May 15** each year. All materials must be postmarked on the due date. When the due date falls on a weekend or holiday, applications are due by 5 p.m. the next business day.
- Please do not send more information than is requested. Pictures, videos, pamphlets, etc., will
  not be reviewed. (diagrams or photos embedded in confines of the description page are
  acceptable.)
- The Foundation strictly adheres to all deadlines.
- Incomplete, incorrect and/or unsigned applications will be returned.
- No faxed or e-mailed applications will be accepted.
- Grant recipients are selected by a panel of reviewers including Foundation board members and community representatives.
- The Foundation will not provide an oral or written explanation for denied applications.
- Applications must be typed.
